


GSG Wind, LLC (GSG Wind) is repowering its 80-megawatt wind energy facility in Lee and Lasalle Counties, IL. The GSG Wind project is situated on 3,000 acres near West Brooklyn, Illinois, and initially reached commercial operation in 2007. Through the repowering effort, GSG Wind is decommissioning and replacing all 40 wind turbines and replacing them with 26 which have an equitable output to the original 40. As part of the repowering, all 120 blades from the original wind turbines are being recycled. The repowering is scheduled to be completed by late 2023.

GSG Wind is expected to operate for 30+ years, providing significant economic investment to the community, a substantial property tax base for the counties and schools, and generate emission-free renewable energy.

Construction on the repowering of GSG Wind began in early 2023 and is expected to be completed by late 2023 or early 2024. The repowering construction brings an influx of jobs to the community as well as additional income for local service organizations.

BENEFITS TO THE COMMUNITY

Wind energy facilities are a beneficial, temporary, and low impact use of land. Benefits of wind projects include:

- Substantial property tax contributions which add low impact, assessed value to the region.
- Approximately 200 new full-time equivalent jobs created during construction.
- Once operational, the wind facility is a passive use of the land and will not generate substantive amounts of traffic, dust, odors, or other nuisances.
- Creates no emissions and requires limited amounts of water during operation.
- Land will be stabilized and seeded, allowing the land to regenerate and the soils to rest.
- At the end of operations, equipment is removed, and the land restored to prior use.
